Parade Route

NEW FOR 2018! Please pay close attention.



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From the staging area along Rose Street—including the Boys and Girls Club and School District Office parking lots, the parade moves East along Rose St. before turning **South on Main St.** The parade proceeds on Main St., running through the heart of downtown, before turning West on Maple St. The parade will officially disband at Maple and Second St. Popsicles will be passed out near the parade terminus.

Popsicles

As a reward for their efforts, participants will receive popsicles afterward, compliments of McBeth Shearing and distributed by Strawberry Festival's Senior Court Queen and Princesses! Popsicles will be handed out at the end of the parade near the old Vinnie's Health Food Store parking lot.

Registration

Registration forms are available at all local schools, the Lebanon Chamber of Commerce, Strawberry Festival's website, or may be requested via email by contacting our Junior Parade team, junioparade@lebanonstrawberryfestival.com.

Completed registration forms may be submitted in advance of the Junior Parade by turning it in at the Lebanon Chamber of Commerce, mailing it to Strawberry Festival at P.O. Box 273, Lebanon, OR 97355, or by emailing it to junioparade@lebanonstrawberryfestival.com. Advanced entries are due prior to Friday, May 25th, and are helpful in expediting your check-in procedure. Alternately, registration forms may be submitted the day of the parade at the staging check-in.

Registration forms must be signed by a parent or legal guardian to be eligible for participation in the Junior Parade.

Rules

- **NO** motorized vehicles will be allowed in the Junior Parade with the exception of those used to pull a float, and must be driven by a licensed adult driver.
- Power wheels will be allowed if accompanied by an adult.
- **NOTHING** may be tossed or projected from participants to spectators. Flyers and candy may be gently handed out.
- All participants shall have turned in a completed registration form signed by a parent or legal guardian.

The Lebanon Strawberry Festival reserves the right to deny or remove any parade entry not adhering to the rules set in place for the safety of all parade participants and spectators.

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- 1) All entries must check in at the registration table located at 5th and Rose St (Boys & Girls Club) upon arrival
- 2) Registration forms must be signed by parent/legal guardian to be able to participate.
- 3) Staging will begin at 12:00 pm, judging will be from 1:00 – 2:00 pm, and the parade will start at 2:30 pm.
- 4) Judges will consider originality, construction effort, and individual theme incorporation.
- 5) **NOTHING** may be thrown, tossed, or otherwise projected in to the spectators. This is strictly prohibited by law, and is essential for the safety of our spectators.
- 6) The parade begins at 2nd and Maple, proceeds East to Main St, travels North on Main to Rose St, turns West on Rose before disbanding at the American Legion parking lot, where popsicles will be distributed to all participants.
- 7) NO motorized vehicles are allowed in the parade with the exception of those used for pulling floats, and must be driven by a licensed adult driver. Power Wheels may be driven by participants if accompanied by an adult.
- 8) Judging will be in the following categories: Decorated bicycles, Decorated wagons and tricycles, Walking groups, Animals, Large Floats, and Small Floats
